Application of Edgar Sadler

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of fornication

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Fifth day of March A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge, P. C. Evans, presiding

Third—I was sentenced to a term of Six (6) Months imprisonment on March 5th 1918, and ~~was~~ was imprisoned in the County Jail of Salt Lake County (where I am still confined) since the 8th day of February 1918.

Fourth—Honorable F. S. Richards prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edgar Sadler I was convicted under the name of Edgar Sadler

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Erma Greenig

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
