and State of Utah, in Sixth Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry Hayes presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence
from One to Five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. F. Hoffman prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of H. H. Webb

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
