and State of Utah, in Second district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Agee presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate  
1 to 10 yrs.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison  
Feb 20 1919

Fourth—Honorable Albee prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Harrison Miller  
I was convicted under the name of William H. Miller

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same  
offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except me
