I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Release upon parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary
under conviction and sentence on a charge of forgery

Second—I was ^{on the 5th} convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of October
A. D. 1917, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in the Fourth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the said penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable J. D. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Charles E. Tolley
I was convicted under the name of C. E. Tolley

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which
I am now serving sentence.
