Application of Sam White

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of 3rd. degree burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th, day of Feb. A. D. 1917, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd. district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Pratt presiding

Third—I was sentenced to from six months to three years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable Dobbs prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Sam White I was convicted under the name of " "

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except burglary.
