

Salt Lake City, Utah, July 30 1917

Application of Pablo Fernandez

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a rehearing and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Armed Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of June A. D. 1914, at Castle Dale County of Carbon Co. and State of Utah, in The Seventh district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge H. A. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence not to exceed two years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on the 12th day of June - 1914.

Fourth—Honorable J. O. Cherry prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Pablo Fernandez. I was convicted under the name of Pablo Fernandez.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frankie Fernandez. of no kin to me.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except never before. Will the Hon. Board of Pardons grant me the privilege of appearing before the board in person. As I wish them to see that in my case that my record is good and that I have worked on the road camps and now am certain that I can go back into freedom and make good.
