Application of Clarence Hendrickson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of extortion

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of March A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd judicial district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. L. Brown presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve one year in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
