Application of Edward Ford

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Deg.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1916, at Logan County of Beache and State of Utah, in Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. D. Ball presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Roy O. Thatcher prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edward Ford I was convicted under the name of Edward Ford

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
