First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Dec day of December
A. D. 1911, at Tropic County of Garfield
and State of Utah, in Second district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable D. J. Lewis presiding

Third—I was sentenced to some ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Cornelius Mannix

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
I received ten long years for stealing a horse out of a barn. I have five

Francisco and a son in Los Angeles. I can go to either one if the Pardon
Board turn me out.
