Application of Frank Borjan Borley Jr.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~Pardon~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 7 day of March A. D. 1916, at Duchesne County of Duchesne and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of one to ten years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. W. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frank Borjan Borley I was convicted under the name of Frank Borley Jr.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this
