Application of H. L. Brooks

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27<sup>th</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup> day of Feb. A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City County of Utah and State of Utah, in County Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to the Penitentiary and thereafter was imprisoned in the Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is H. L. Brooks I was convicted under the name of H. L. Brooks

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: George Brooks

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Served three months in Salt Lake County Jail
