Application of Harry Elliott

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of March A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable C. W. Moore presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for 5 months and 15 days in the Road Camp
Ever since

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Harry Chauncie Elliott
I was convicted under the name of Harry Elliott

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Mr. Arch. Brewster

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
