

Salt Lake City, Utah, April 22nd 1917

Application of Charles Durkee.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of June A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Richtie presiding

Third—I was sentenced to one to five years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison.

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Charles Durkee

I was convicted under the name of Charles Durkee

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: no one

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except in Colorado

I served time there in prison, but I can truthfully say I never served time in any other place, as I have been in Utah and Colorado nearly all of my life
