Application of Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the twenty eighth day of March A. D. 1916, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. H. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Ed. Jackson I was convicted under the name of Ed. Jackson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
