Application of THOMAS C. BENSON

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Felony.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of September A. D. 1915, at Parowan County of Iron and State of Utah, in the Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joshua Greenwood presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Imprisonment for Two years in the State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Edmond H. Ryan prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Thomas Cornelius Benson I was convicted under the name of Thomas C. Benson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No one.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
