Application of Sam Espinoza

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of June A. D. 1914, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Tronsworth prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Samuel Espinoza I was convicted under the name of Samuel Espinoza

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joe Martinez & Frank Gonzales

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except One - previous to this one - a term of one year in San Quentin, California
