Application of Bert Blount

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~term~~ <sup>re-hearing</sup> and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of May 1916 A. D. at Logan Utah County of Coke and State of Utah, in First judicial district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. D. Call presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to six months to 3 years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Prison 10 months

Fourth—Honorable Ray D. Shashw prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Bert Blount I was convicted under the name of Bert Blount

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except yes in Colo
