Application of Sam Kirkpatrick

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Second Degree Murder

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of January A. D. 1912, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable C. F. Loofbrow presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. C. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Sam Kirkpatrick I was convicted under the name of Sam Kirkpatrick

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: ~~Mr.~~ Parley Newberry

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except No.
