Application of Fred S. Fleming

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

Termination of Sentence

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for g and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Indecent Assault

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of July A. D. 1914, at Tooele County of Tooele and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five Years -- Indeterminate and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frederic Seymour Fleming I was convicted under the name of Fred S. Fleming

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except "Felony" --- California.
