Application of Paul Van Houton

Nov 1th

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a credit and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Battery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 3 day of Feb 1908 A. D., at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah; in Judge Armstrong Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Armstrong presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to fifteen years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth—Honorable Mr. Judge Gouffredo prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Paul Van Houton I was convicted under the name of Paul Van Houton

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Geary Wilson and Jack Richardson

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except I was arrested before this charge.
