Application of Thomas Vance

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

Commutation of Sentence

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a/.....and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Assault With Intent to Commit Murder

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of October A. D. 1910, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Twenty Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Thomas Vance
