Application of J. E. Burgess

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of Attempting to obtain money by false pretenses

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Justice's Court, J. B. Scott Justice Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Scott presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve 90 days

and thereafter was imprisoned in the County jail of Salt Lake County

Fourth—Honorable R. D. Ellmore prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is J. E. Burgess I was convicted under the name of J. E. Burgess

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
