I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault & Battery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of March
A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City County of Wasatch
and State of Utah, in Judge - Lund's Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry B. Lund presiding

Third—I was sentenced to 60 days

and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail

Fourth—Honorable Ray Elsmore prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Otto Apelgren
I was convicted under the name of the same

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same
offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
and had very extenuating circumstances.
