Application of Frank Kuntz

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termin and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of December A. D. 1916, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in the 4<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan Dist. Judge presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate from 6 months to 3 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison of Utah

Fourth—Honorable J. H. Mc Donald Dist. Atty. prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frank Kuntz I was convicted under the name of Frank Kuntz

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the Present
