Application of Edward Powers

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Assault with a deadly weapon

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February A. D. 1918, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. W. Agee presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve a term not to exceed five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Atty. S. P. Dobb prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edward Powers I was convicted under the name of Edward Benson alias Ed Powers

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Mike Sullivan

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this
