A. D. 1915, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. A. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve from Six Months to Three Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison
