Application of R. J. Dixon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Assault with a Dangerous Weapon

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of December A. D. 1915, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in The second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. C. Smith presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to from one to two years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable District Attorney C. W. Harris prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Robert J. Dixon I was convicted under the name of R. J. Dixon

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except that one
