First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of October A. D. 1914, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Pitckie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable C. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.
