First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of May A. D. 1914, at Beaver County of Beaver and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joshua Greenwood presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Thirty (30) Months and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Daniel J. Ryan prosecuted the case.
