Application of Leroy Guthrie

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of December A. D. 1914, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. H. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison eight months

Fourth—Honorable J. R. Davis prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Leroy Guthrie I was convicted under the name of Leroy Guthrie

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
