Application of William Samuelson

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of Feb. 1914 A. D., at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to five years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable C. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Samuelson I was convicted under the name of William Samuelson
