Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1915, at Ogden County of Weker and State of Utah, in 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. A. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable John C. Davis prosecuted the case.
