Application of Lawrence Von Arnim

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of July A. D. 1915, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable C. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is H. P. Lawrence Von Arnim I was convicted under the name of Lawrence Von Arnim
