Application of Frank Harris

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Fourth day of December A. D. 1915, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the third judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge C. W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison five months and nineteen days

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Joseph Howard Young
I was convicted under the name of Frank Harris

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: P. W. Haines

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the aforesaid
