Application of Joe Mulder

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for ~~Pardon~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of December A. D. 1915, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable C. W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Southwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Joe Mulder I was convicted under the name of Joe Mulder

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except none
