Application of Adolph Moll

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of May A. D. 1914, at Logan County of Cache and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. D. Hall presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five years imprisonment

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison. On September 18, 1915 I was granted a conditional Pardon.

Fourth—Honorable Roy S. Thatcher prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Adolph Moll

I was convicted under the name of Adolph Moll
