Application of Thomas Wade Anderson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Murder Second degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the eight day of March A. D. 1910, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to fifteen years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison six (6) years

Fourth—Honorable T. C. Lofthouse prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Thomas Wade Anderson I was convicted under the name of Thomas Wade Anderson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
