Application of William Schingrees

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of voluntary man slaughter

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of September, A. D. 1915, at City of Salt Lake, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Charles W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to indeterminate term recommending one year by the judge and district attorney and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary am now employed on state roads

Fourth—Honorable P. T. Farnsworth prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Schingrees I was convicted under the name of Bill Schingrees

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this offense and this being purely self defense
