Application of R. J. Rifon

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Assault with Acid

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of December A. D. 1915, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in The second Judicial Dis. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. A. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve from one to ten years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. C. Davis prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of R. J. Rifon
