Application of Wilford E. Rasker

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

*Commutation*

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of having morphine in my possession

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 32<sup>d</sup> day of August A. D. 1914, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. A. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. E. Davis prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Wilford E. Rasker  
I was convicted under the name of Wilford E. Rasker

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery committed at Ogden, Oct. 1912, for which crime I served ten months in State Prison
