Application of William Mc Gandless

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1915 at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable E. L. Jones prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Mc Gandless I was convicted under the name of William Mc Gandless

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Mrs. Anna Carter

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
