Application of James W. Anderson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of Feb. A. D. 1915, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joseph H. Erickson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to An indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable John Z. Sewey prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is James W. Anderson I was convicted under the name of James Anderson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Above

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Above
