Application of Vincenzo Monturo

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail Carbon Co. under conviction and sentence on a charge of Manslaughter

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of June A. D. 1916, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. H. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of one year in the County Jail of Carbon County, Utah and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of said county

Fourth—Honorable J. W. Leary prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Vincenzo Monturo I was convicted under the name of Vincenzo Monturo

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
