Application of Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of March A. D. 1914, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritzler presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Two years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable A. R. Furnessworth prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Walter Smith

I was convicted under the name of W. W. Smith

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Nothing
