Application of Walter Cripps.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of April A. D. 1915, at Kanab County of Kane and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jos. H. Erickson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of not to exceed five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable John L. Sevy, Jr., prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Walter Alfred Cripps. I was convicted under the name of Walter Cripps.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
