Application of TOM POULUS

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Pardon} and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of conducting a gambling house

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of August A. D. 1915, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable C. W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of imprisonment

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Athanasios Poulejos

I was convicted under the name of Tom Poulus

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None

Eighth—I entered the prison on September 2, 1915, and was paroled on October 19, 1915.
