Termination of Sentence

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a / and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of December
A. D. 1913, at Castle Dale County of Emery
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. H. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve from One to Twenty years the
judge's recommendation being that I serve Two years.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable O. W. Cherry prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Albert Ringling
I was convicted under the name of " "

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except what is known, under the
Colorado law, as a confidence game. The specific charge was that I
hired a motor car without sufficient means to pay for it. For that
offense I was sent to the Colorado state reformatory.
