Application of Jerry Jackson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Termination of Sentence} ~~commutation~~ respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third (3rd) Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of March A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable C. W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Recommended Six (6) Months State Penitentiary Salt Lake City, Utah

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jerry Jackson I was convicted under the name of Jerry Jackson
