First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the tenth day of January A. D. 1921, at Mantoloking County of San Pete and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Vern Bills I was convicted under the name of Vern Bills

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: X Carl Terkelson

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
