Application of Ralph Morales

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

Conditional Pardon

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. P. W. Morse presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Scattergood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Ralph Morales I was convicted under the name of Ralph Morales

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Jack Wilton

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except none
